# MISS FRONTIER DAYS PAGEANT

## ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS AND RULES & REGULATIONS



1. Contestants must reside in the Carson City-Crystal School District.
2. Contestants must be between the ages of 14-19 years.
3. Contestants must submit two photographs of themselves, with at least one being a head shot.
4. Contestants must submit a \$50.00 entry fee with their application. The sponsor or contestant may pay the fee with a check or money order payable to Carson City Frontier Days, Inc.
5. Contestants must not be married, divorced or co-habiting with a male in lieu of marriage.
6. Contestants must not be pregnant or ever been pregnant.
7. Contestants cannot be suspended or expelled from school at the time of the pageant, nor the Queen during her reign.
8. Former Frontier Days Queens will not be eligible to compete in the pageant.
9. Contestants are required to participate in all pre-pageant events and rehearsals.
10. Contestants will be judged on evening wear and western wear, initial impression, poise and personality, attire selection and appearance, confidence and composure, public speaking skills, and overall attitude.
11. Contestants, if chosen as Miss Frontier Days, must attend five festivals/functions in addition to the Frontier Days Festival, especially between May and September. Carson City Frontier Days is always the first weekend in June.
12. Once chosen, Miss Frontier Days may not hold or run for any other title during her reign.
13. Miss Frontier Days must remove all visible body jewelry during her representation of the crown, excluding earrings. All tattoos must be covered.
14. If a contestant has charges brought against her in a court of law while participating in the pageant process, including the reign of the chosen Miss Frontier Days, she will be dismissed from participation. This includes but is not limited to misdemeanors, felonies, truancy and lawsuits. Routine traffic violations do not count.
15. In the event of Miss Frontier Days not being able to fulfill her duties, all awards and prizes must be relinquished to the next eligible contestant in line.
16. Miss Frontier Days and the 1st Runner-Up should always dress attractively. They have the option of wearing a gown or attractive dress at parades. The Queen and the 1st Runner-Up should wear their crowns and sashes for all appearances whenever they are representing Carson City Frontier Days. When not performing an assigned duty during the festival, neat and casual attire is acceptable. (No halter tops, tube tops, short shorts, or mini-skirts please.)
17. Scholarship money will be awarded to Miss Frontier Days at the conclusion of her reign. All checks will be written to the winner. In the event that the Queen is excused from her title for any reason, the scholarship will be forfeited.
