FEES AND PRIZES

- No fee to play ... that's right - it's FREE!
- Prizes to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th place teams.

TEAM COMPOSITION

- Teams can be any combination of male and female players.
- All ages welcome.
- 32-team limit.

TOURNAMENT RULES (Please remember ... this is Backyard Cornhole for FUN!)

- Boards are placed 27-feet from front edge to front edge.
- Games are played to 21. No "Bust" rule.
- Woody: Refers to any cornhole bag that has been pitched and remains on the board playing surface at the conclusion of the fram. Each Woody is worth 1 pt.
- Cornhole: Refers to any cornhole bag that has been pitched and passes through the board hole at any time within the frame. Each cornhole is worth 3 pts.
- A bag that comes to rest touching the ground AND the board does not count as a point.
- Cancellation Scoring: The approved method of scoring for the sport of cornhole is "cancellation" scoring. In cancellation scoring, the points of one player cancel out the points of their opponent.
- Both players play one board at a time and stay in their designated lane for the whole game.
- Players start the game at one board and alternate pitching bags until each player has pitched all 4 of their bags.
- Players must deliver the bag with an underhanded release. Overhand deliveries will be counted as 0.
- Feet must stay behind the line of the front of the board at the time of releasing the bag.
- The team who scored in the preceeding frame pitches first in the next frame. If neither team scores, the team who pitched first in the preceeding frame shall retain first pitch in the next frame.
